Springboard is an innovative program providing community-based rehabilitation therapy and education for adults with severe and multiple physical and cognitive disabilities following traumatic or acquired brain injury (ABI).

### *Accessing the Program*

Referrals are generally made through the Brain Injury Options Co-ordination agency.

Participants may attend on either one or two days each week.

A fee for service may apply for compensable participants.

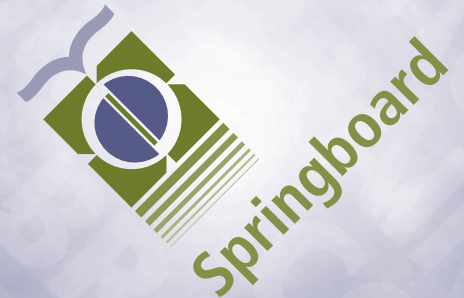
